

## BUSINESS IMPACT ESTIMATE

As required by Sec. 166.041(4), *Florida Statutes* (2024), this “Business Impact Estimate” is provided for Ordinance No.:

### ORDINANCE NO. 400

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF MANALAPAN, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE MANALAPAN CODE OF ORDINANCES AT TITLE XI: - BUSINESS REGULATIONS. AMENDING SECTION 112.02 HOURS OF SALE. TO REPEAL THE PROHIBITION ON ALCOHOLIC SALES DURING THE MORNING HOURS OF SUNDAY; PROVIDING THAT EACH AND EVERY OTHER SECTION AND SUBSECTION OF TITLE XI. BUSINESS REGULATIONS SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT AS PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE, A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND AUTHORITY TO CODIFY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**Part I. Summary of the proposed ordinance and statement of public purpose:** Ordinance 400 amends the Town’s Alcoholic beverages provisions to remove the prohibition against the sale of alcohol during Sunday morning.

**Part II. Estimate of the direct economic impact of the proposed ordinance on private, for-profit businesses in the Town of Palm Beach Shores:**

- a. Estimate of direct compliance costs that businesses may reasonably incur if the proposed ordinance is enacted:** Nominal positive impact. Businesses will have expanded options for times in which to sell alcoholic products.
- b. Identification of any new charges or fee on businesses subject to the proposed ordinance, or for which businesses will be financially responsible:** No new charges or fees are being charged by the Town.
- c. An estimate of the Town of Manalapan’s regulatory costs, including an estimate of revenues from any new charges or fees that will be imposed on businesses to cover such costs.** No change from pre-ordinance costs.

**Part III. Good faith estimate of the number of businesses likely to be impacted by the ordinance:** Businesses which conduct alcohol sales within Town limits.
