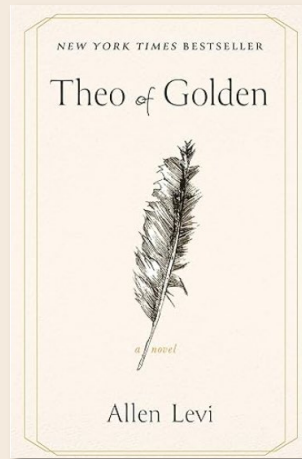


2026 Book Club Series
